...好 (hou2) + adj. *very...*

有少少... (jau5 siu2 siu2) *a little...*

容易 (jung4 ji6) *easy*

難 (naan4) *difficult*

學中文好難。 (hok6 zung1 man2 hou2 naan4) *Learning Chinese is very difficult.*

學中文有少少難。 (hok6 zung1 man2 jau5 siu2 siu2 naan4)

*Learning Chinese is a little difficult.*

A + adj. 过 (gwo3) B *A is more...than B*

A 容易過 B。 (A jung4 ji6 gwo3 B) *A is easier than B.*

學 A 容易過學 B。 *Learning A is easier than learning B.*

(hok6 A jung4 ji6 gwo3 hok6 B)

學英文容易過學中文。 *Learning English is easier than learning Chinese.*

(hok6 jing1 man2 jung4 ji6 gwo3 hok6 zung1 man2)

煮 (zyu2) *to cook*

煮雞肉拉麵容易過煮火雞拉麵。

(zyu2 gai1 juk6 laai1 min6 jung4 ji6 gwo3 zyu2 fo2 gai1 laai1 min6)

*Cooking chicken ramen is easier than cooking turkey ramen.*

A 多過 B。 (A do1 gwo3 B) *A is more than B.*

我鍾意 A 多過 B。 (ngo5 zung1 ji3 A do1 gwo3 B) *I like A more than B.*

Anita 鍾意食面多過食粥。 *Anita likes to eat noodles more than congee.*

(Anita zung1 ji3 sik6 min6 do1 gwo3 sik6 zuk1)

Anita 鍾意食面多啲。 *Anita likes to eat noodles more.*

(Anita zung1 ji3 sik6 min6 do1 di1)

Anita 鍾意你多過佢。 *Anita likes you more than him.*

(Anita zung1 ji3 nei5 do1 gwo3 keoi5)

Anita 鍾意你多啲。 *Anita likes you more.*

(Anita zung1 ji3 nei5 do1 di1)
